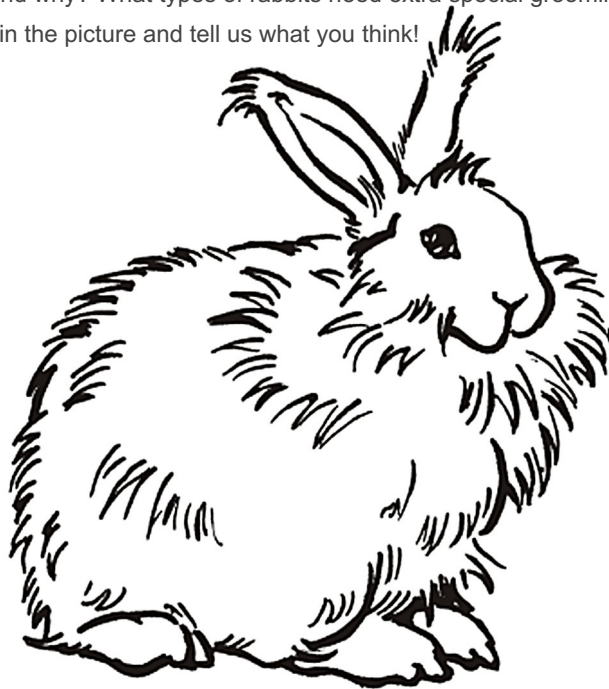
Our series of fun activities are designed to help educate and make learning about rabbit welfare fun too.
